Current special needs for 2011. These needs are over and above the monthly support needs:

- \$7,123.00 Help in building the Teedpaosgo Apostolic Mission Church in Sector 30, Karpala, Ouagadougou. This congregation was planted by Daniel in the 1990's. They have moved around to various locations, and now have their own property in a new development of Ouagadougou. The building was under construction when strong winds blew down the free standing walls at the end of May 2011. Total Cost of reconstruction and completion of the building \$10-12000 (walls, roof, windows doors, floor but no ceiling, electricity or paint). The rest of the cost of the basic construction is covered by local contributions.
- \$1,500 Bursaries for two Burkina Mennonite Students to attend Maranatha Bible Institute in Bobo-Dioulasso, Burkina Faso for the school year 2011-12. Total Cost: 1,727. The rest of the cost is covered by the Mennonite Church in Burkina. These two students have been selected by the national church council for pastoral training. Sidi Traore is a Sicite speaking believer from Kotoura, and Aboubakar Konde is from Orodara.

As of August 31, 2011, - % of our regular support for Sept. – Dec. has been received or pledged. As of August 31, 2011, \$536 has been donated for the church building project. Thank-you!
